Mohammad Ali Jinnah played crucial role

Salient feature of the Pact

- Muslim League demanded for communal reservation, accepted by Congress.
- Muslim got the reservation which is twice than their population in some region.
- Communal veto system was accepted for the first time.
- Agreement on self government, abolition of Indian Council, Dominion status
- Salaries of Secretary of State should be paid by British government.

Although this pact united Congress and League which helped in growing the nationalisms in country.
