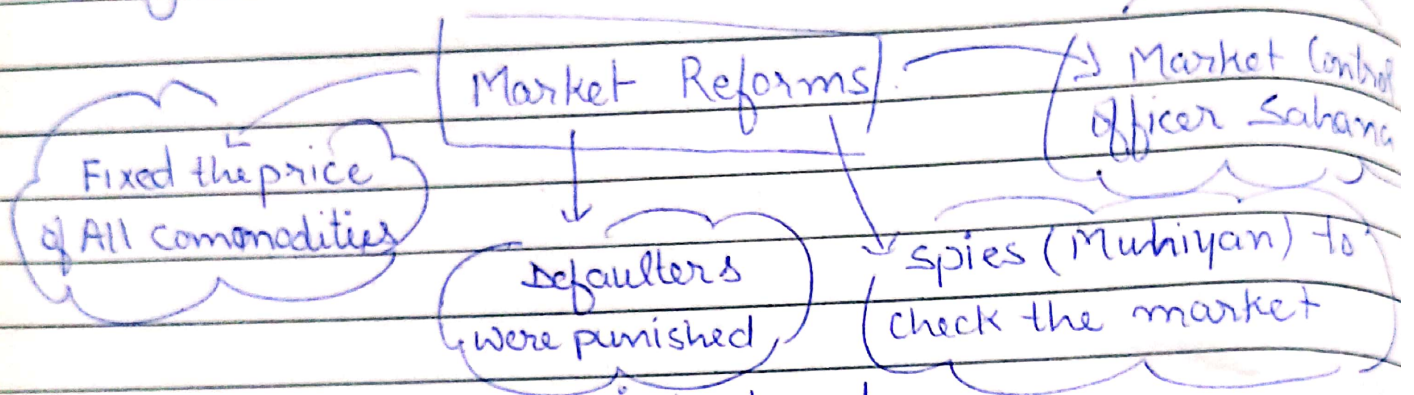


# Market Reforms of Ala-Ud-din Khulji
