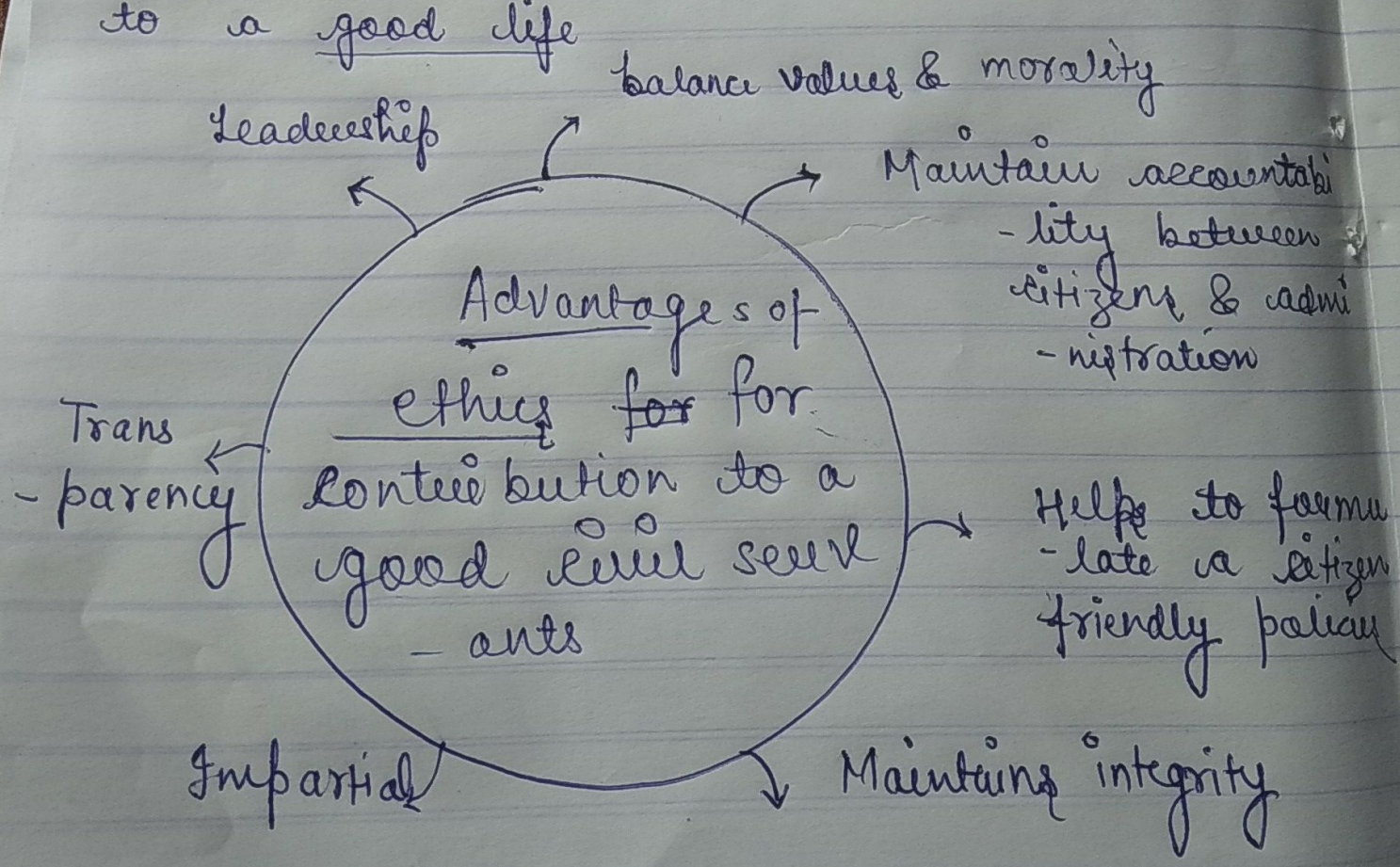


Q. 1.7 Explain how ethics contributes to a good civil servant and a good public administrator (150 words).
