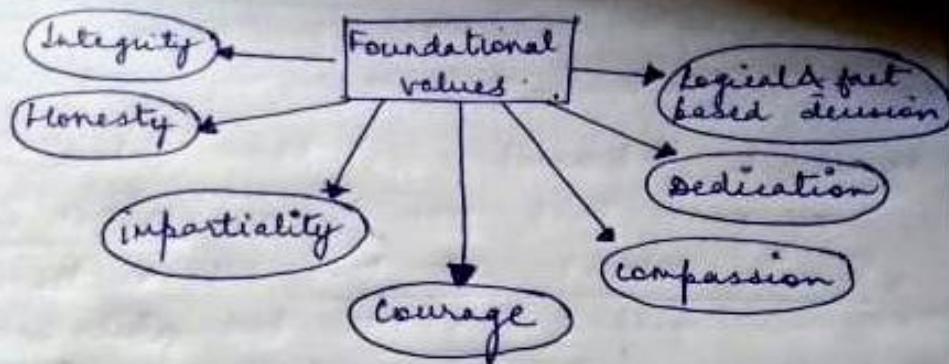

Civil servants are expected to perform their duties for the betterment of the public and the society and to do their services with successfully.
A civil servant must have the following foundational values:



1. Courage: Refers to performing the public duties in the favour of public and not under the pressure of any other party.
2. Compassion: Refers to feeling for the deprived section of society and taking necessary actions for their betterment.
3. Impartiality: A civil servant's behaviour and actions must be free from bias or personal interest.
4. Dedication: towards his/her duties for the welfare of the public.
5. Rational Decisions: taking decisions on the basis of facts, data and proper analysis.
