1. ~~Gulletering~~ → Gulletering
When the demand for grants is passed without debate & discussion its c/d Gulletering.

2. Token Cut -
When the demand for grants is passed but grants is reduced by Rs 100/- its called token cut.

3. PAC - Public accounts committee.

- Its financial committee of parliament.
- Members - 22, 15 from LS & 7 from RS.
- Functions - It examines the audit report of CAG and asks explanation from concerned authority for the objection raised by CAG.
- It carries out financial scrutiny.
- Criticism - Its role is neither preventive nor curative but just postmortem.
- Lacks specialisation.
