Ans United Nations Security Council is a 15 member body, consisting of 5 permanent and 10 non-permanent members elected on biennial basis of 2 year term by General Assembly.

Reasons for India's bid for permanent seat

- ④ India is 5th largest world economy of the world.

Hurdles against India's seat

- ① India has not signed NPT and CTBT.

④ India imports most of its military equipments.

⇒ Need for Democratisation in Security council.

② Veto power in hands of specific countries becomes hurdles in decision making.
