Ans) Disaster is defined as a catastrophe affecting large section of society.

Disaster management is defined as a counter management to a disaster including the reduction of deaths and damages as well as protection of victims with speedy recovery.

comprises of 2 elements :- (1) Pre-disaster (2) Post-disaster

The current machinery involves the approach of Community-based disaster management (CBDM) which involves identification, analysis, treatment & evaluation of disaster risks.

The National disaster Management Act (2005) comprises of -

- Establishment of National disaster management Authority (NDMA) headed by Prime Minister.
- This established NDMA at the root-levels i.e. even at the district levels.
- A disaster management Response force is also established by the help of parliamentary forces.
