'The Rajarajeshwara Temple at Tanjore' with 80 tonnes of gold at the top and famous for the Lord Shiv Temple. & Gangai Konda Cholapuram constructed by Rajendra chola also famous for Lord Shiva temple. Impressive rock-cut statues and architectures, the famous Bronze statue of Nataraj.

Thus, the chola temples flourished under the royal patronage of imperial chola kings. Chola temples have been recognized for their international importance and special protection under world heritage by UNESCO.
