Disaster Management. Current Machinery in India (100W)

Disaster can be termed as catastrophe, calamities & sudden disturbances caused by natural & man-made activities. Management of disasters with systematic planning, coordination, staffing, reporting, budgeting, reporting, directing & coordination can be seen as disaster management.

## CURRENT MACHINERY

In India there is National Disaster Management Act 2005.

1) National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA): headed by PM.

2) State & District Disaster Management Authority (SDMA & DDMA): headed by CM and District Magistrate.

3) National Executive Committee: consists of nine members with the tenure of 5 years.

4) National Disaster Response Force (NDRF): To ensuring proper disaster management nationally and internationally.

Ex - i) Operation Ganga<sup>(2022)</sup>: Get back students of Indian origin from Ukraine.

ii) Operation Dost<sup>(2023)</sup>: To help the citizens of earthquake hit Turkey.
