Ans As per Article 153 - Governor is executive head of state and he performs his duties on advice of C.O.M. or by himself as per Article 154.

Through this "Or By himself" mentioned in Article 154 Governor enjoys Two Category of Discretionary Powers.

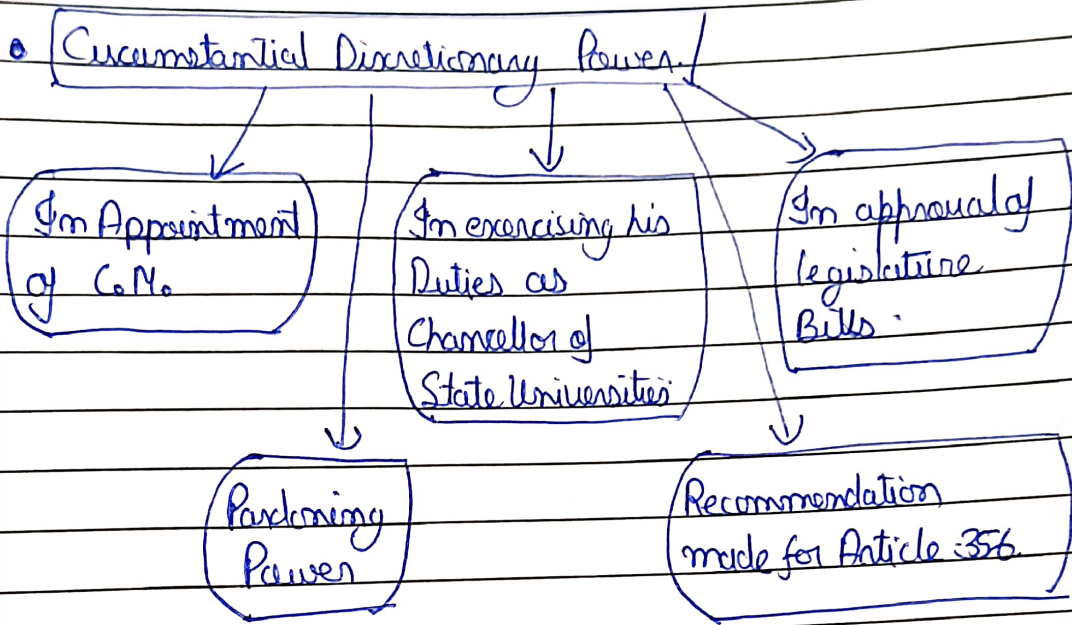
