Ans. The Preamble is the brief introductory note at the beginning of our constitution. It sets out guidelines, which guide the people of the nation, and to present the principles of the constitution.

The hopes and aspirations of the people are described in it.

- Democratic Republic: India has adopted a representative parliamentary democracy. Elections are held for every office including the head of the country.
- Justice: Aim of securing, social, political and economic justice for all.
- Liberty: Constitution provides the freedom of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship.
- Equality: All are equal before the law. Equality of status and of opportunity.

- Fraternity: A spirit of brotherhood is necessary among its people. Dignity of each individual is preserved and respected.
- Secularism: Discrimination on the basis of religion is neither allowed nor followed by the state.
- Socialism: Introduced by the 42nd amendment in 1971. Establishment of social, economic and political equality.
- Aimed at bridging gap between rich and poor.
