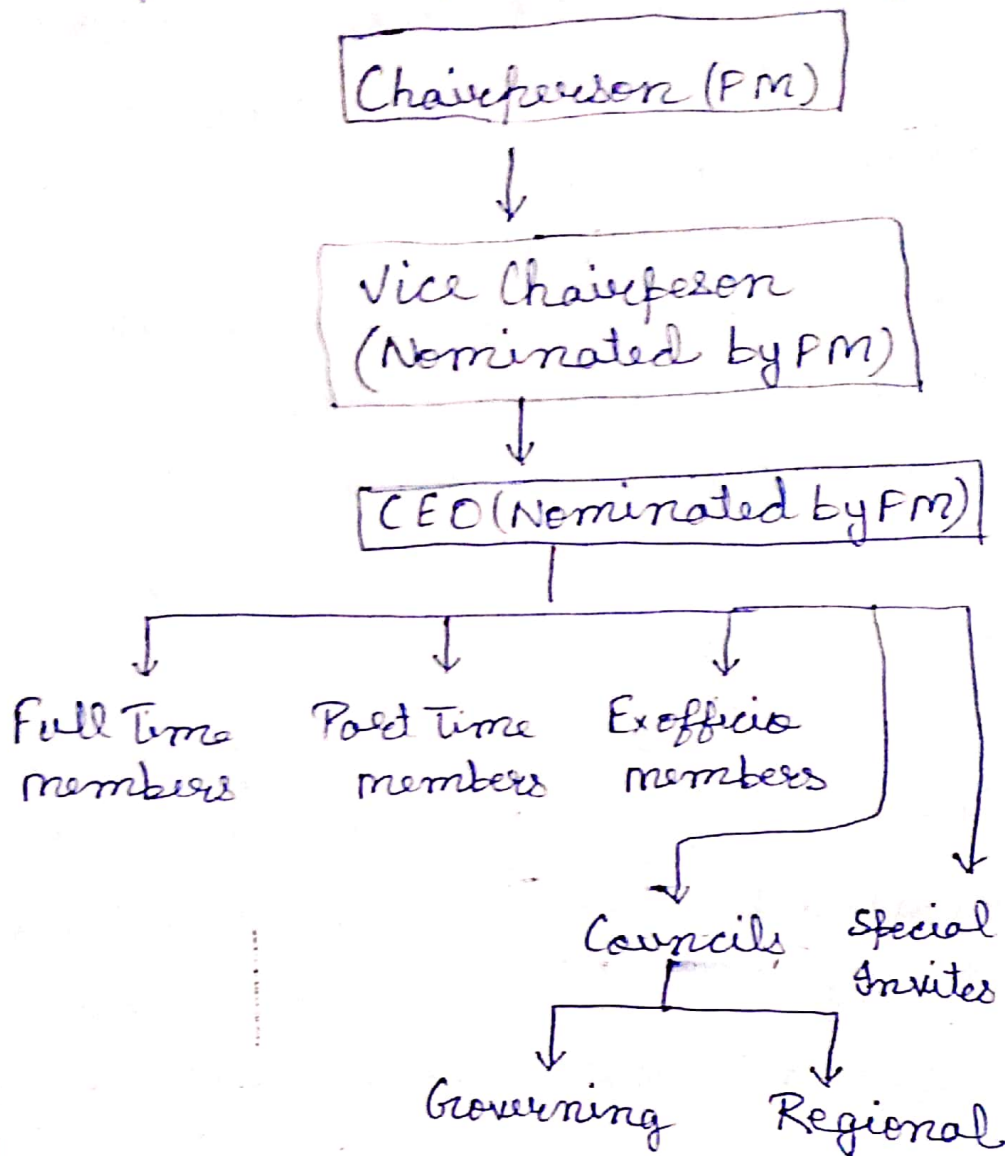

Key Changes Brought By NITI Aayog In Indian Planning:-

1. The NITI Aayog sets a 15 year plan for government actions for achieving social goals such as poverty reduction and improving health and sanitation.

2. After demonetisation of high value notes, NITI Aayog has devised new initiative to push Indians to go for digital payments.
3. The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is the most significant cleanliness campaign by the govt. of India. The main aim of this abhiyan is to create awareness among people for cleanliness.
4. The Aayog also suggested various social programmes and centrally sponsored schemes under 28 umbrella projects.
5. Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojna is a national Mission on financial inclusion which has an integrated approach to provide banking

facilities to all household in the country.
