

• What do you mean by glorious revolution?
Compare glorious revolution with French and Russian Revolution. (200 words)

Glorious revolution is the English revolution which took place in 17th century, which totally changed the image of the country. It was a bloodless revolution which merely ended in a year and caused drastic structural changes, without any mishap, hence named glorious revolution. It ~~over~~ reduced the power of king and set up a constitutional monarchy which gave equality and freedom to people.

French revolution and Russian revolution were somehow different from English revolution. They ~~were~~ have taken long time for completion like in French revolution. The revolution in France was due to atrocities of higher classes whereas that in Russia was due to ignorance of duties of Tsar Nicholas.

English revolution was more of a peaceful revolution, allowing the king to flee, showing respect and no proper bloodshed, whereas in French revolution the king ^{& queen} were given guillotine, those who opposed revolution were killed (reign of terror) and forts and palaces were attacked.

English revolution ended in constitutional monarchy whereas French revolution in dictatorship whereas Russia got communism later which turned into dictatorship. The success rate and moral values of English revolution seems to be higher.
