to be followed in public life? 200 words

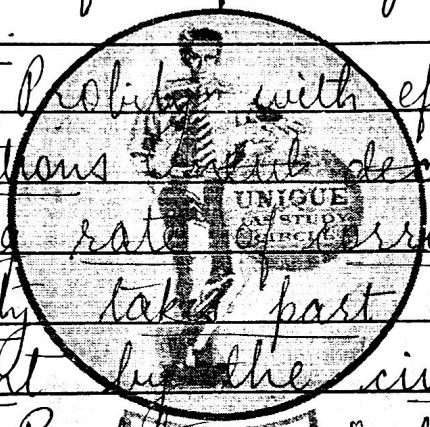
Ans -

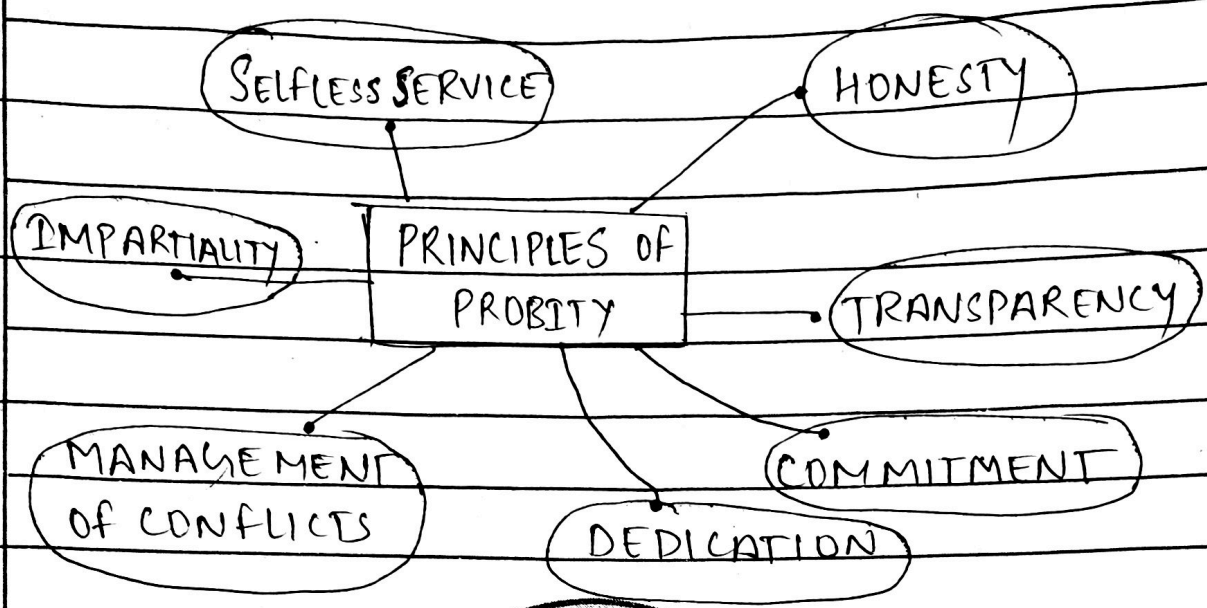

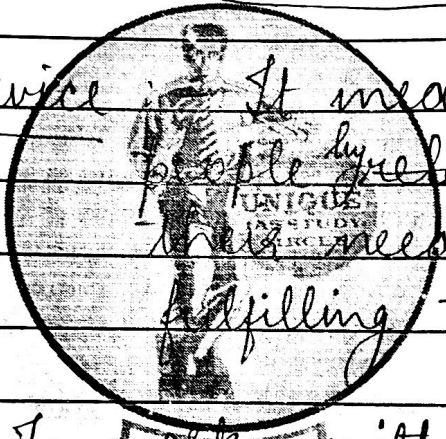

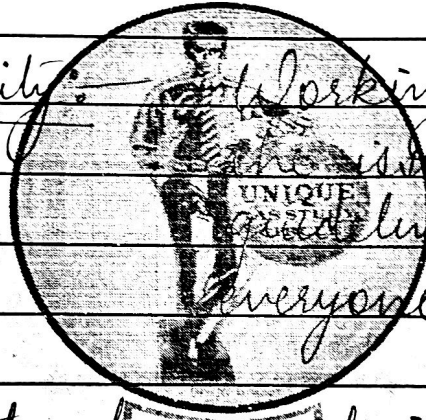
