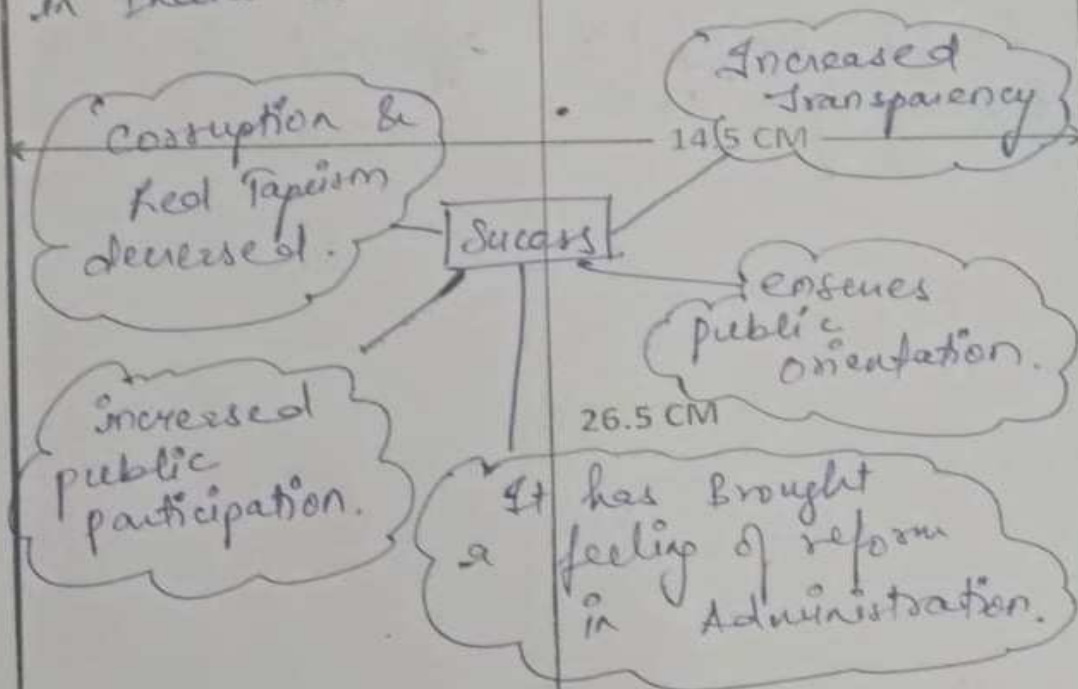

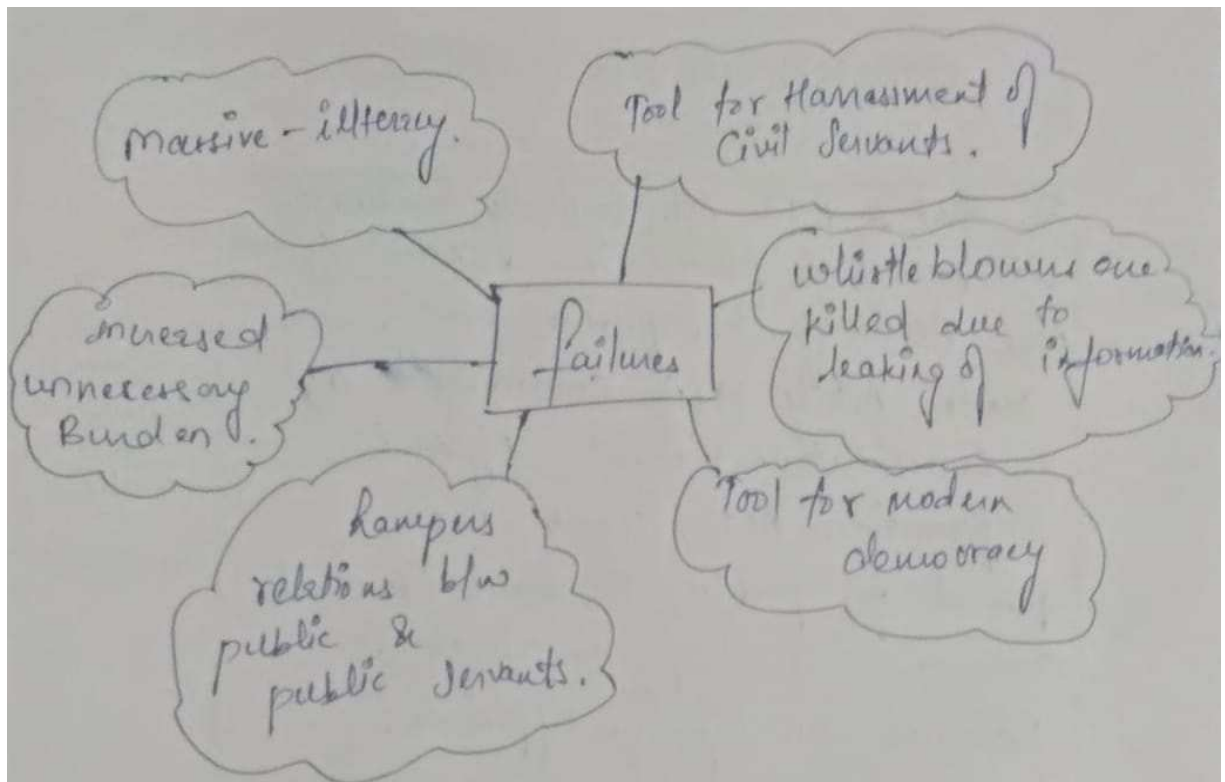
Q. What is RTI Act. Critically Evaluate its success & failure in India. (1500)
