

5. What is ethical governance? How ethical governance is helpful for public welfare?

Ethics is an important part of governance which comes from within the civil servants. Being ethical will help the civil servant directly to direct his action for public interest. Ethical governance is not a rule based governance but it is value based governance. It focuses on —

1. more social good, less individual good
2. comes from within, not from outside
3. moral principles involved.
4. Public interest is supreme.
5. Better policy making, effective implementation, accountability of actions & answerability
6. Protection of values.
7. Conduct of 'right' acts.

Ethical governance is helpful for Public welfare.

- (a) It makes the public more satisfied.
- (b) Effective implementation of policy as the public servant who practices ethical governance enjoys popularity.

- (E) utilisation of resources effectively & efficiently
- (D) Corruption free system as moral values will not allow such practices
- (C) More efficient staff, as their primary motive will be public interest.
- (F) better service delivery to the citizens.
- (A) It also encourages transparency in system.
- (H) Public recognition will boost the civil servants to do their best for public being with moral values & ethics.

Ethics is a vital part of governance, unethical people can't be a part of efficient governance, and can't lead to public interest in an area.
