* MAJOR CHARACTERISTICS OF INDIAN CONSTITUTION :-

(i) Parliamentary form of Government - The Bicameral legislature system is followed in India.

(ii) A Unique blend of rigidity and flexibility.

(iii) A Federation with a strong centralising tendency.

(iv) An Independent Judiciary

(v) A secular state where no separate religion for the state and every religion is respected equally.

(vi) Indian Constitution has essential feature of Judicial review which helps in proper functioning.
