Freedom of Willingfull Payment of Religious Tax

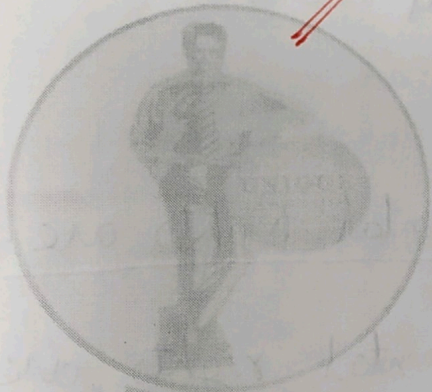
