

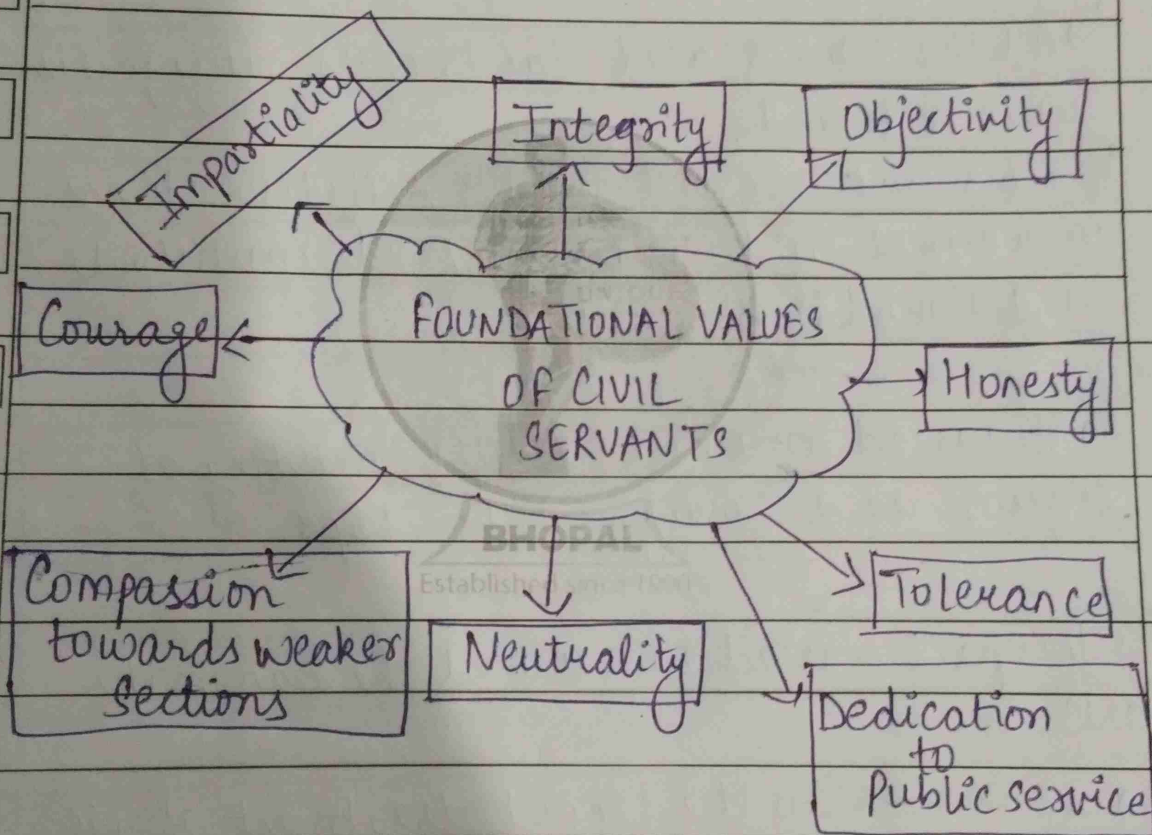

Q. 1 Explain the foundational values required in civil servants? [200W]

A. 1 Foundational values are set of rules, principles and belief that help civil servants in discharging functions in proper and efficient manner.



(i) Integrity :- Integrity is regarded as the honesty and truthfulness or accuracy of one's actions. Civil servants should act in a way that is professional and fulfill the duties and obligations.
