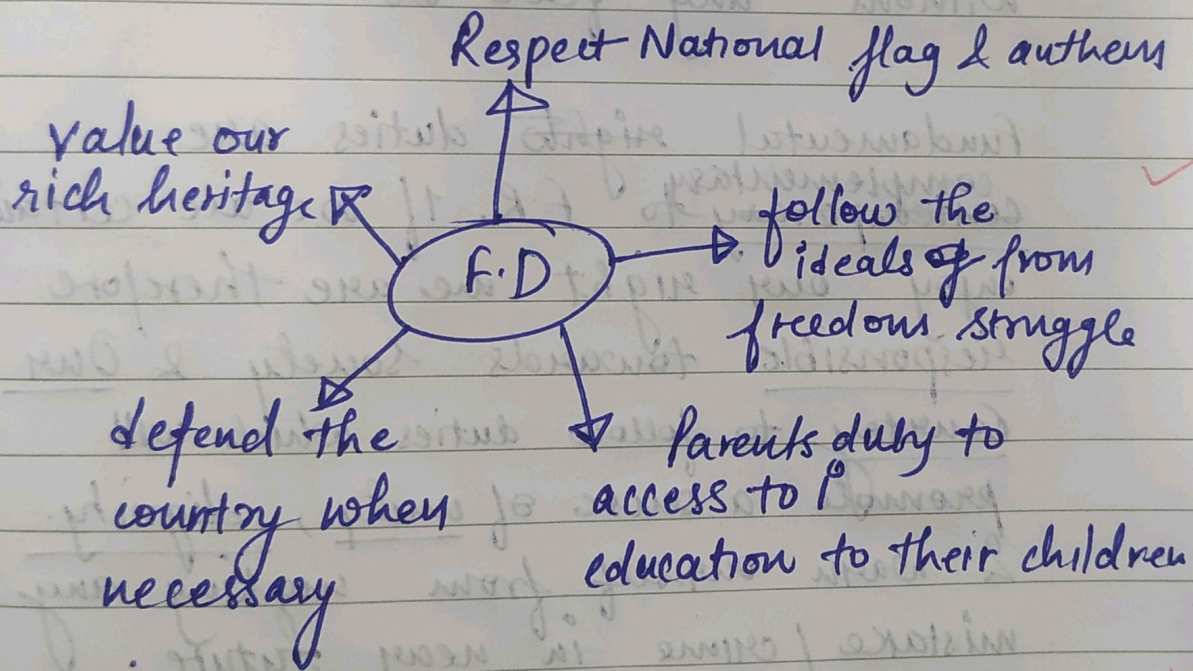

ans :- Fundamental duties are incorporated in part IV-A of constitution by 42th Amendment act 1976. Originally there were 10 F.D, later on 1 more was added by 86th constitutional amendment act 2002.

Unlike fundamental rights which were present in constitution from the beginning fundamental duties on the other hands was added later on
