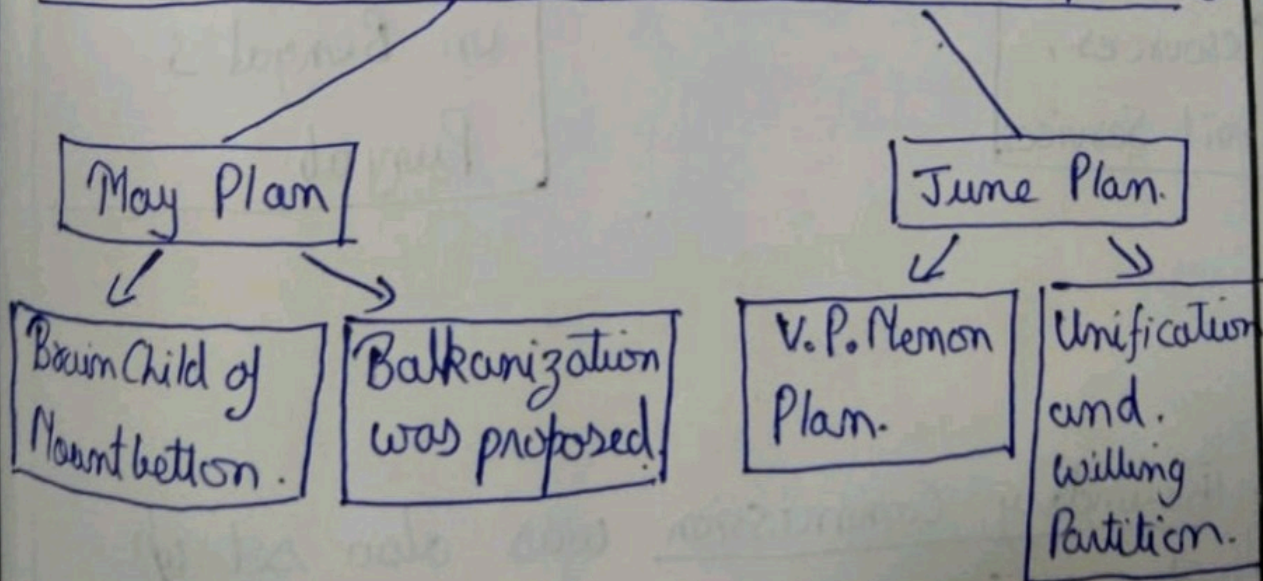


Q. What was Mountbatten Mission? What is its role in Indian Independence?

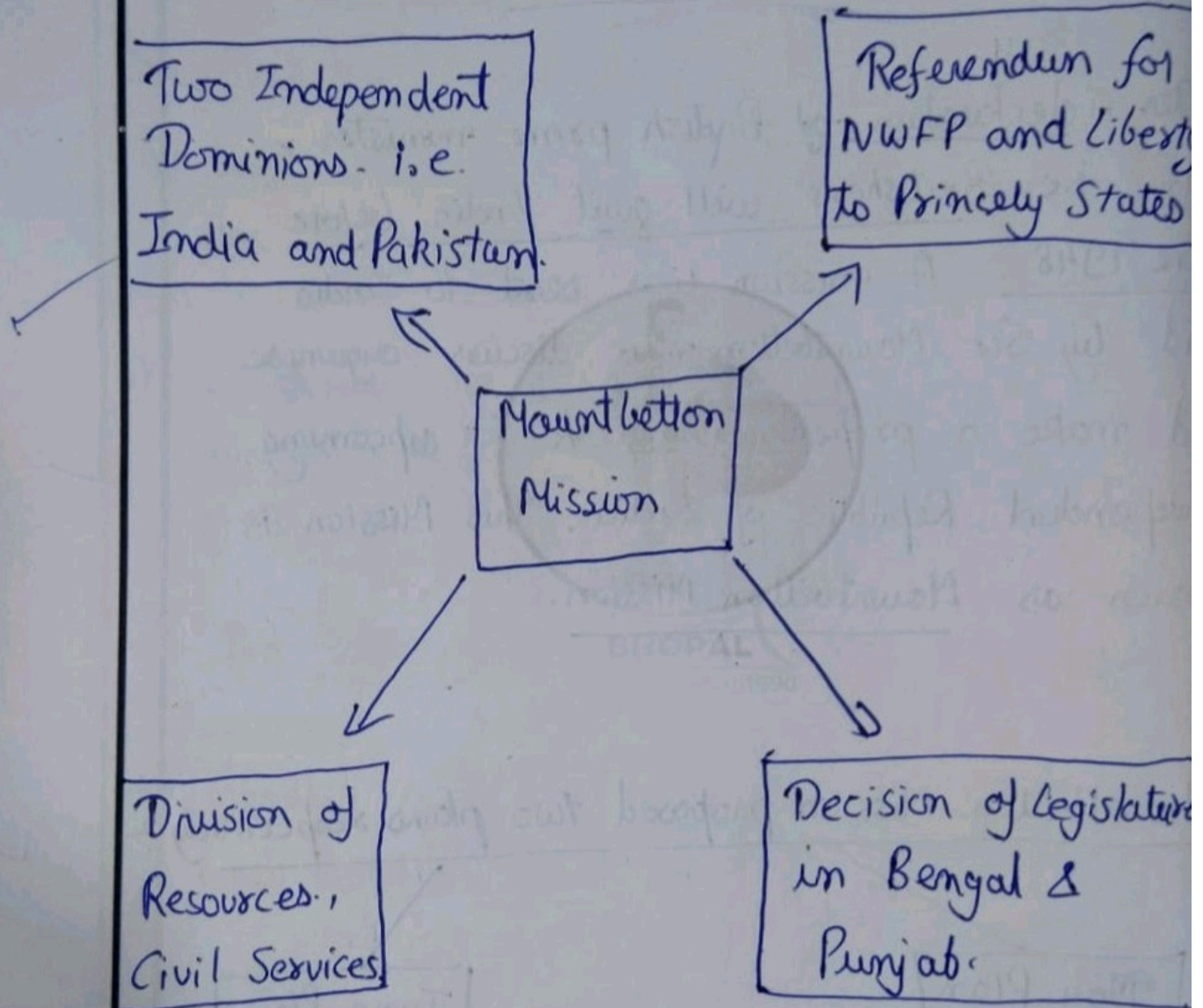
→ Mountbatten Mission proposed two plans respectively:

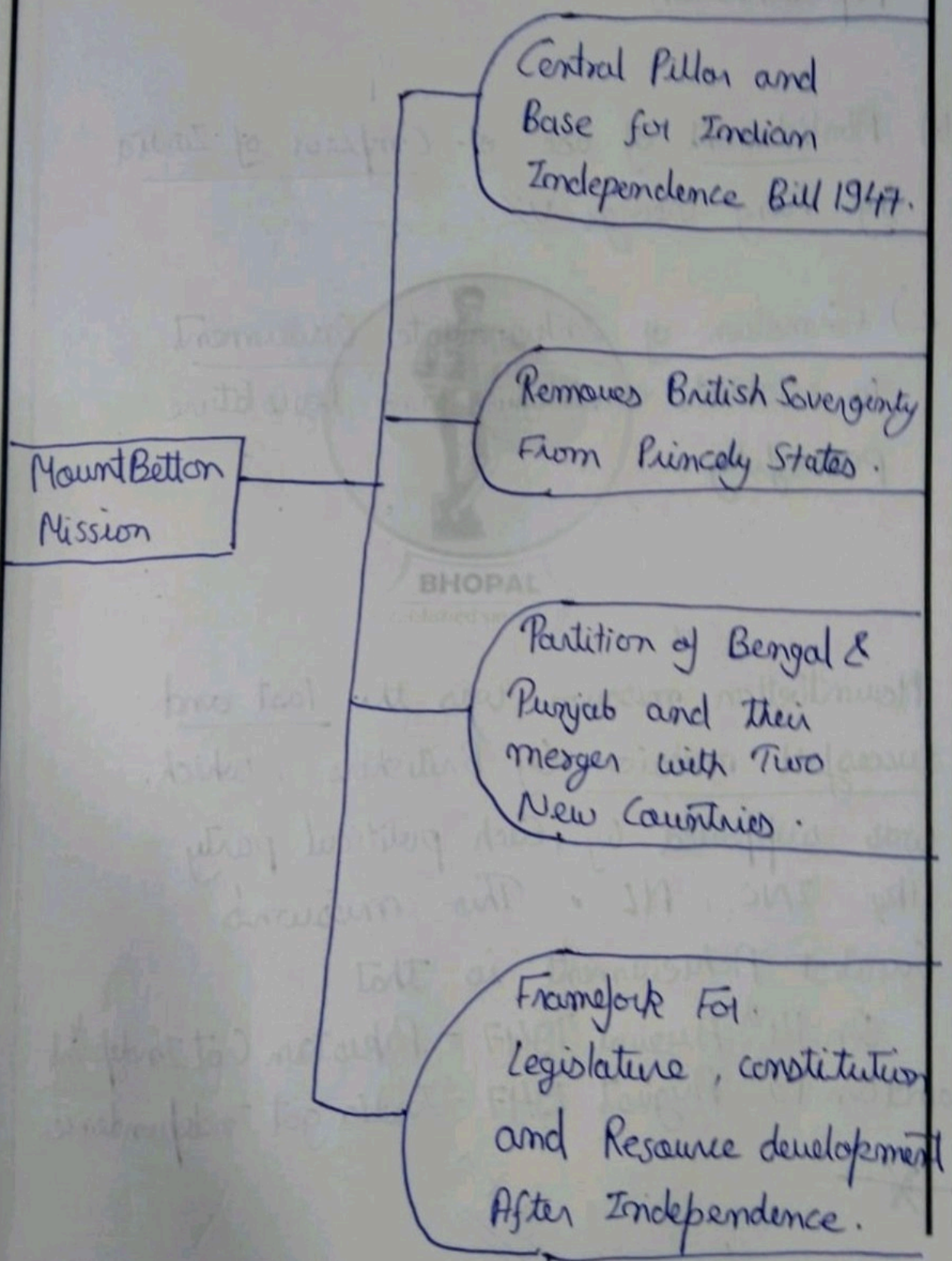

→ Boundary Commission was also set up under Sir Cyril Radcliffe to draw International Borders Between India & Pakistan

→ Role in Indian Independence of Mountbetton Mission



- a) Establishment of Governor General office in each country for British crown.  
Representation
- b) Abolishment of use of Emperor of India by King George-VI.
- c) Formation of Intermediate Government to establish constitution and legislature peacefully.

On 14<sup>th</sup> August 1947 - Pakistan got Independent
