The number of candidates to be admitted to the Main Examination will be about twelve to thirteen times the total approximate number of vacancies (Every year approx 1000) to be filled in the year in the various Services and posts.

Subject to minimum of 30 marks in paper-1, 70 marks in paper-2, paper 2 in qualifying in nature. CS (Prelims) 2017 cut off was- 105.34/200 marks, CS (Prelims) 2018 cut off was- 98/200 marks

AGE LIMIT — The candidate must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 32 years (for the General category candidate) on August 1 of the year of examination. Prescribed age limits vary with respect to caste reservations.

- For Other Backward Castes (OBC) the upper age limit is 35 years.
- For <u>Scheduled Castes</u> (SC) and <u>Scheduled Tribes</u> (ST), the limit is 37 years.
- For Defence Services Personnel disabled in operations during hostilities, the limit is 35 years.
