The word Ethics is derived from Greek word "Ethos" meaning "character". Ethics are the guiding principles of defining what is right & what is wrong.

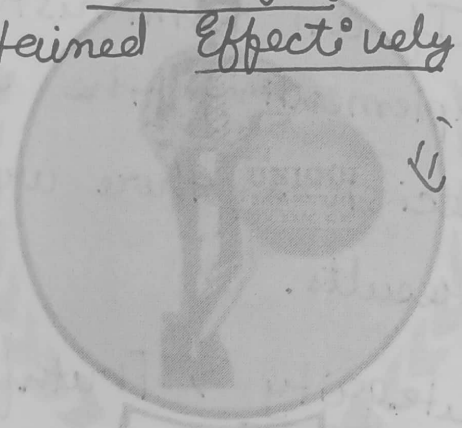
Role of Ethics in Public Administration:-
