There are various challenges to the internal security:

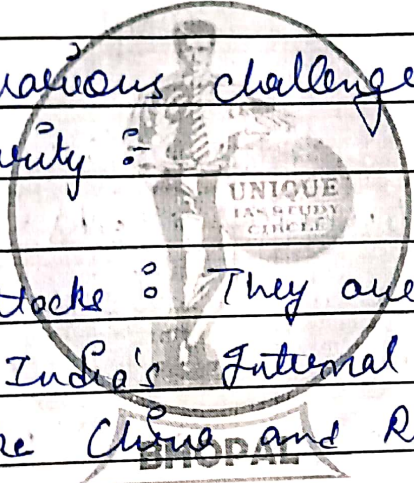
→ Cyber attacks: They are a common threat to India's Internal Security. Various

→ National Investigation Agency: This agency was also formed after the terrorist attacks in Mumbai. It was formed to investigate into the threats against internal security.

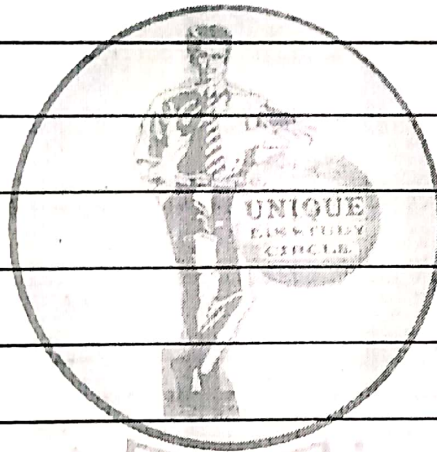
→ Crime & Criminal Tracking Network System: This system comes under the e-governance
