Q.- Elaborate differences b/w Rule of law found in UK with Administrative law found in France. (75W)

In U.K. there is equality before law i.e. everyone is equal in the eyes of the law whereas in France there is no equality before the law as there are separate Courts for separate Individuals (eg. Criminal Investigation Court, Ordinary Courts etc.)

A. In U.K., there exists two courts namely Civil Court for petty-day to day crimes & the other as Criminal Court for heinous or more serious crimes. In contrast with France, Courts in U.K. are divided on the basis of degree of crime ~~unlike~~ France which is based on division according to Ordinary Citizen, Constitutional Matters etc.
