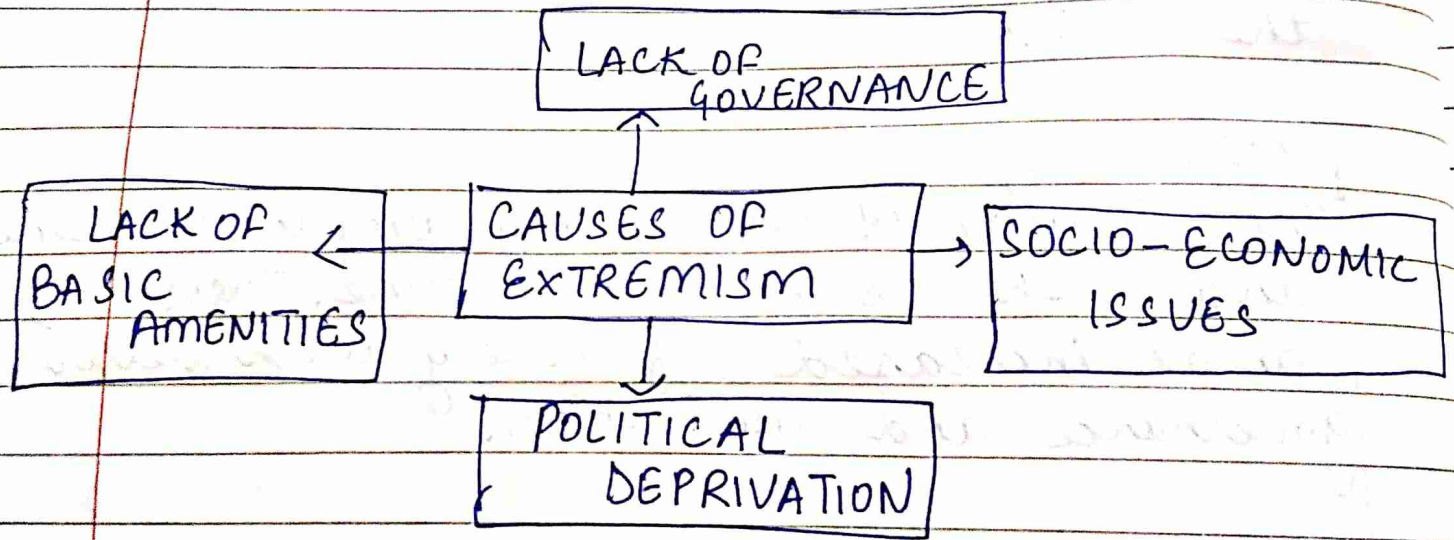


Q.2 Critically analyze the lack of development as backward linkage for Extremism in India. [250W].

* DEVELOPMENTAL ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH DEVELOPMENT AND SPREAD OF EXTREMISM

1. IMPROPER POLICIES:- Improper policies and their ineffective implementation may result in extremist activities among weaker sections of society.

2. LABOUR, UNEMPLOYMENT, WAGES: Another issue that spread extremism is joblessness which creates insecurity of living. This brings dissatisfaction in urban and rural areas and also youth is being ignored.
3. SOCIO-ECONOMIC ISSUES: Most of the people entering in extremism are lacking primary education, basic amenities and infrastructure.
4. LACK OF GOVERNANCE: Due to lack of governance and proper mechanism to settle conflicts and disputes in the society these factors create extremist feelings among sufferers.
5. BASIC FACILITIES: It is observed that government fails to provide infrastructure and services as per national norms that gives rise to extremism affected areas.

* WAYS TO RESOLVE EXTREMISM IN INDIA:

1. MODIFICATION IN POLICIES: Modification in government policies by considering backward people in society can resolve extremism in India.
2. GOOD-GOVERNANCE: Introducing the concept of good-governance and timely resolving disputes and conflicts in society can tackle this situation.

3. PROVIDING FACILITIES: Government should provide basic facilities among the people in these areas which spreads extremism.
