Q. What is Fugitive Economic Offender Act 2018? What are its salient features? How will it prevent the fugitive economic offenders?

Fugitive Economic Offender Act 2018 is an attempt of Indian government to prevent the likes of Narayana Rao, Vijay Mallya & Amitabh Choudhary. The act was put on March 12 in Lok Sabha and got presidential assent on 31st May 2018.

The act aims to prevent the culprits from evasion of legal process and fugitive from the country, and if a person does this then before it claimed as an "Economic Offender". An Economic Offender is an individual against whom an arrest warrant for a scheduled offence has been issued by any court of India, the offence being not less than 100 crores.

The authorities appointed under the "Preventing of Money Laundering Act, 2002" will be the same for this act. The Enforcement Directorate will be the investigative agency for this act. The directorate plays an important role here as he carries

the burden of the property and also he
possess the power equivalent to the
powers of a civil court. Apart
from this, he is responsible for
decency and inspection, receiving
affidavits, documents, witness etc
and an administrator will be appointed
for the purpose of attachment and
confiscation of the property.

The consequence to be faced
by the economic offender apart
from the confiscation of properties
is that, he/she will not be able to
defend any civil claim by any court
at tribunal in India. Further any
company or limited liability partnership
where the person holds a marginational
position will also be barred from
filing or defending a civil action.

The progress in this field
has not been gained a momentum yet
but is expected to see some development
soon.
